

The Bolivar R-I School District is accepting applications for the Director of the Exceptional Pupil Cooperative for the 2010-2011 school year. The successful candidate will have a master's degree or higher from an accredited institution, DESE certification as a Special Education Director and a minimum of five years administrative experience in special education. The Exceptional Pupil Cooperative, located in Bolivar, serves 14 member school districts in southwest Missouri with a total child-count of 1300 students.

Duties and responsibilities of the Director of the Exceptional Pupil Cooperative include the following: Supervision, assignment, and scheduling of 70 employees. Direct services are provided for 260 students enrolled in classes for Early Childhood Special Education, Developmentally Delayed, Deaf/Hard of hearing, and an alternative school. Services are also provided to each district by traveling ECSE Itinerant teachers, OTs, PTs, Adaptive P.E teachers, Teachers of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing, Teachers of the Blind/VI, Behavior Consultants, Speech/Language Consultants, & Special Education Consultants/ Diagnosticians.
